Fall Baptism Class



TEXT | Genesis 35:1-4, 37:1-4, 50:15-21
Job 1:20-21, 42:1-6 & Matthew 26:36-46

Synopsis

Our journey through the narrative of the scriptures takes us to the last twenty chapters of Genesis and the book of Job, where we meet Jacob, Joseph and Job – three men who faced unique challenges. They all had to trust in God's goodness in irregular circumstances. What can we learn from Jacob, Joseph, and Job, and how can we apply it to our lives today?

Blessing and Benediction



At Nazareth, we want to lift up vibrant, congregational singing as an integral part of our time together on Sunday mornings. Using Spotify, these "Music Spotlights" are designed to encourage us and help familiarize us with most or all of the music selections for the upcoming weekend so that we can wholeheartedly sing in full voice as we worship together.

This coming weekend, we will close our service by singing, "Sent Forth by God's Blessing." Based on a traditional Welsh tune, this melody has been set to numerous lyrics – both secular and religious in nature. At Nazareth, we typically sing this hymn as closing hymn (where it's especially fitting for a communion service) or during Thanksgiving (with "Let All Things Now Living" as an alternative text).

In the mid-1900s, lyrics for "Sent Forth by God's Blessing" were penned by Omer Westendorf, one of the earliest lyricists for Roman Catholic liturgical music, who was inspired to translate the Mass settings he had discovered in Europe into English. Westendorf is also composed "Where Charity and Love Prevail" and "Gift of Finest Wheat" – two texts that we've used at Nazareth for special music or as a communion hymn.
